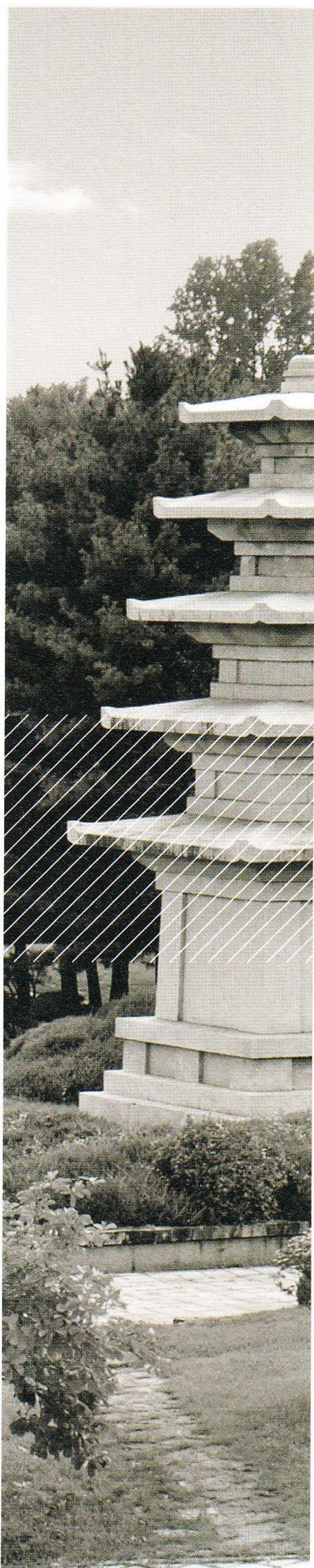
Chungnam National University(CNU) is one of the most prestigious national universities in the nation. Since the establishment in May, 1952, CNU has played a national leading role in educating national communities' economic and social development. We have been providing an outstanding and challenging curriculum that enable academically superior students to become professional scholars.

Daejeon is South Korea's fifth largest metropolis with 1.5 million population. Located in the center of South Korea, Daejeon serves as a hub of transportation and is at the crossroads of major

3+1 TWINNING PROGRAM



Dual degrees from two universities in one year

Chungnam National University (CNU) is looking for talented students from all over the world to join 3+1 Twinning Program (Dual degree program) at undergraduate level. Through the program, students from overseas partner institutions can obtain dual degrees from CNU and home university in just one year. Students will have an opportunity to study at CNU for one academic year and earn one fourth of graduate credits of CNU.



Half the time, twice the result

Traditional dual degree program has been required at least two academic years of study and more than one half of the graduate credits to grant a degree. Twinning program asks shorter period of time and lower financial burden than traditional program. CNU had worked on developing Twinning program in subject areas of Animal and dairy sciences, International Trade, and Architectural Engineering with carefully chosen overseas partners. Take an ideal opportunity to study abroad and get dual degrees in half the time.



Department introduction

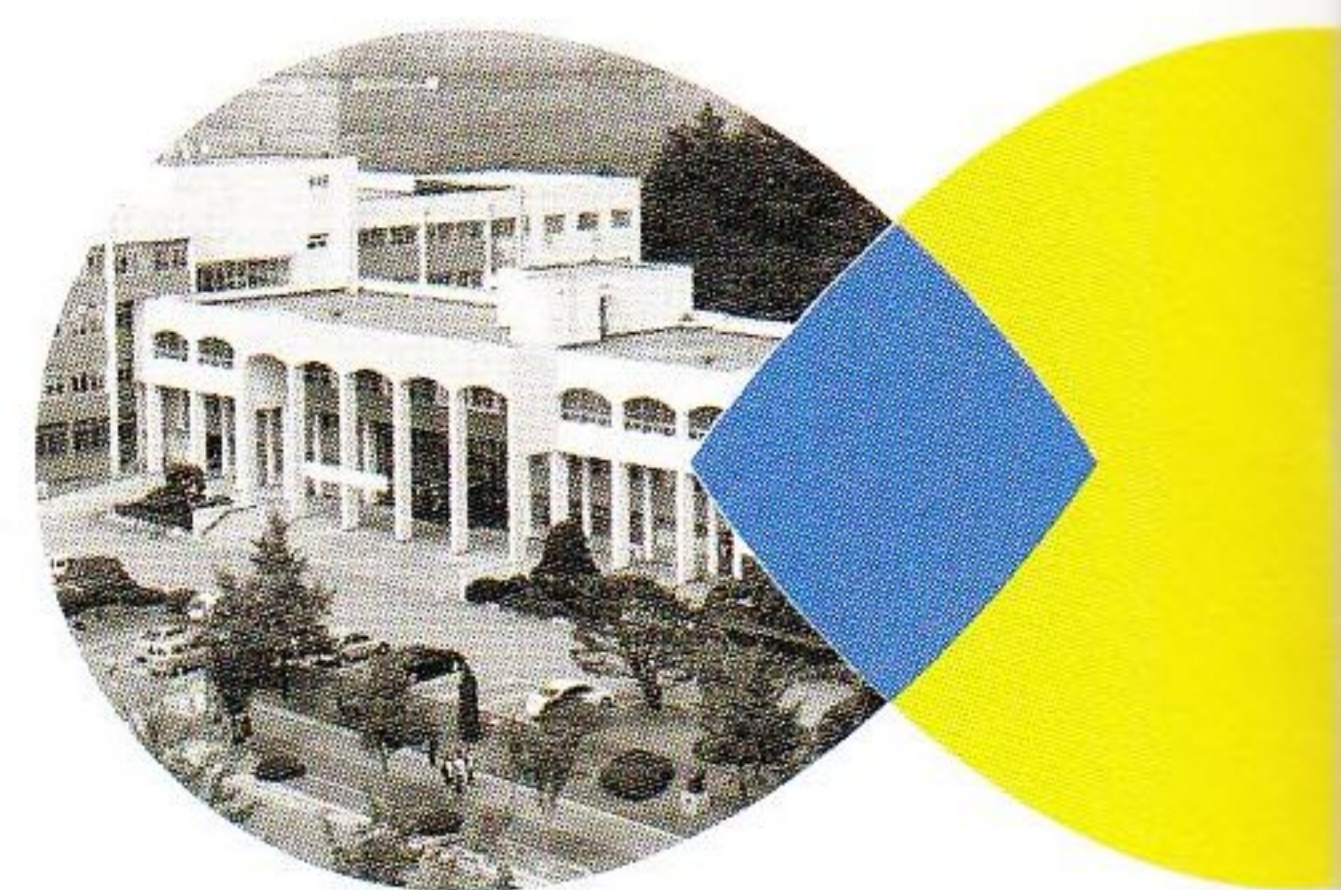
Division of Animal and Dairy Science

Recently, **animal and dairy sciences** have been extended from traditional farm animals like cattle, pigs, and chickens to wild birds, fish, experimental animals and pets. In this light, we are covering both domestic and wild animals that used as objects of resources for human beings. Overcoming the limitation of the early industry, animal and dairy sciences have changed as a comprehensive industry that now embraces the industry of processing and distribution. The area of animal and dairy sciences studies has been enlarged and specialized through improving production and inventing new functional materials by the automation of equipment, and bioengineering technique. The purpose of these studies is to accept the change of the new era to develop the area of animal and dairy sciences and animal industry, and also to encourage excellent individuals to work in the practical industrial sites. Career opportunities are in animal science-related administrations and research institute, meat processing companies, various animal resources-related companies, pharmaceutical companies, medical and biotechnology-related companies, pet animal industries, intensive animal production enterprises, feed-related companies, and the press in relation to agriculture and animal science.



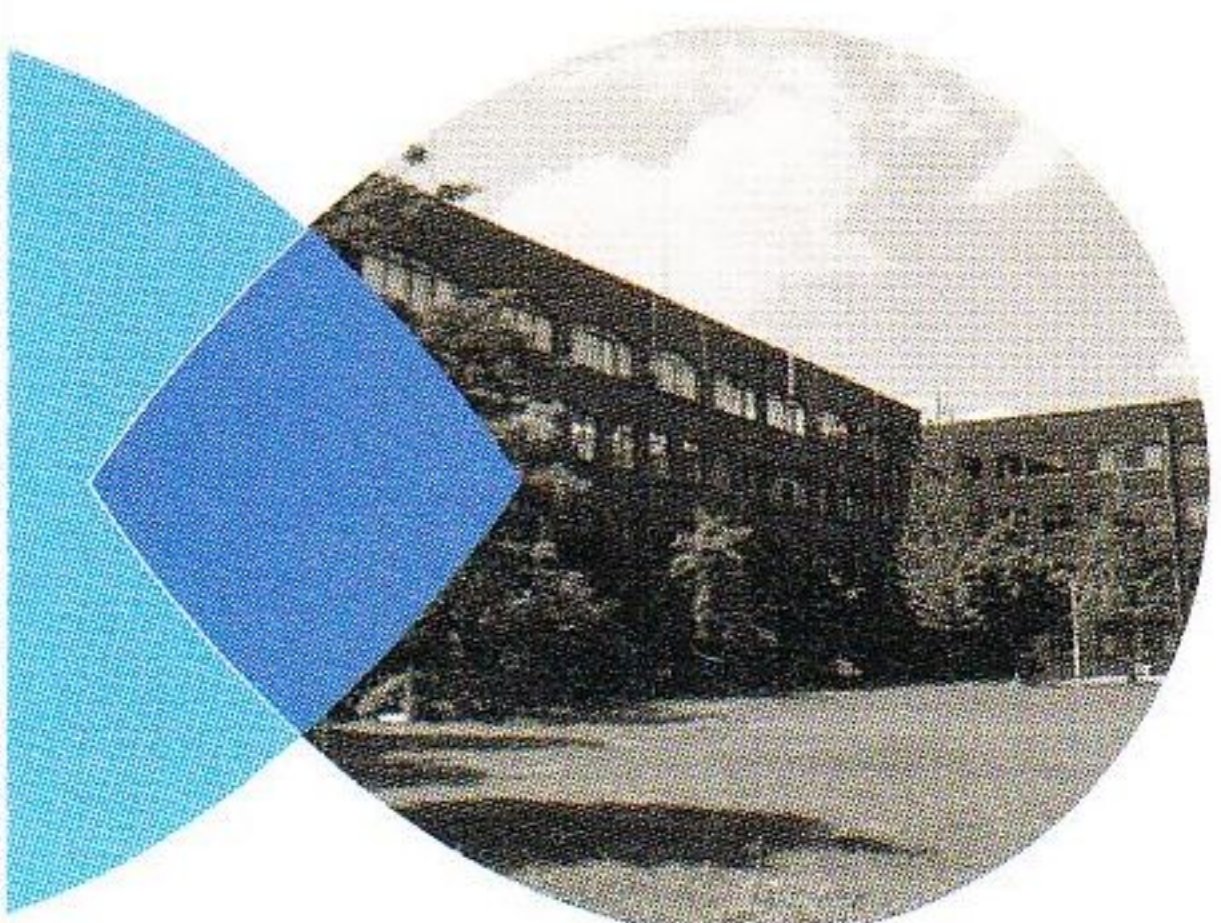
Department of International Trade

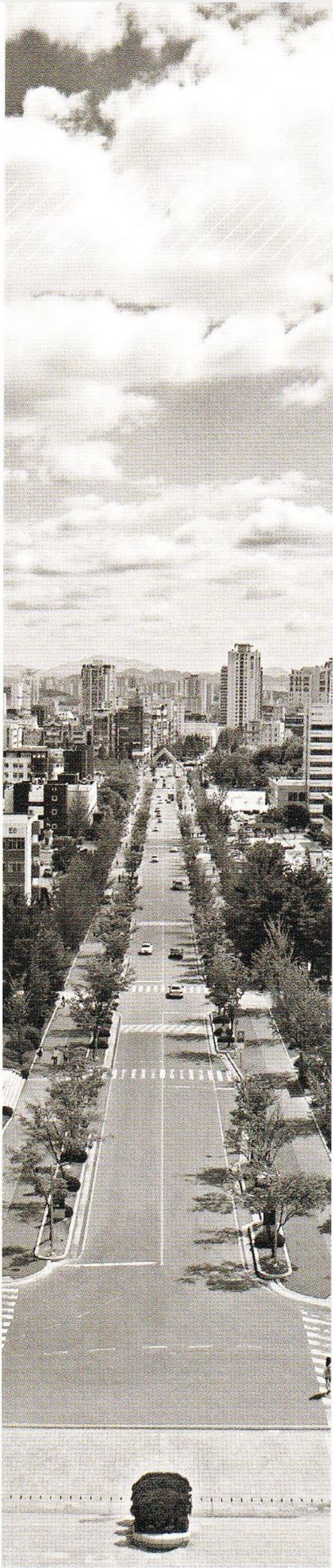
The Department of International Trade place a high value on both teaching and research with the aim of contributing to the corporate and academic community. The undergraduate program assists students in understanding and developing their unique global-leadership qualities. Courses are taught in the areas of international trade theory, foreign exchange, trade environment, trade practice, e-business, cyber-trade, and so on. Specialties include foreign languages (English, Japanese, and Chinese) for international business. Members of the department have received numerous teaching and research awards and have initiated experiential learning with courses like e-business. The department has been consistently highly ranked in national surveys.



Department of Architectural Engineering

The Department of Architectural Engineering is dedicated to cultivating professional engineers who have creative and practical experiences, as well as who can creatively provide human living spaces. To accomplish this purpose, the department emphasizes on a balanced education between fundamental liberal arts and sciences. The undergraduate program of the department has been accredited by Korean Engineering Accreditation Commission, ABEEK, and also, satisfies the ABET requirements. The department is supported by the Brain Korea 21 plus program, a government-funded graduate school level program. The curriculum consists of four basic fields of education and research: Architectural Planning and Design, Structural Engineering for Buildings, Building Materials & Construction Engineering, and Architectural Environment Engineering.

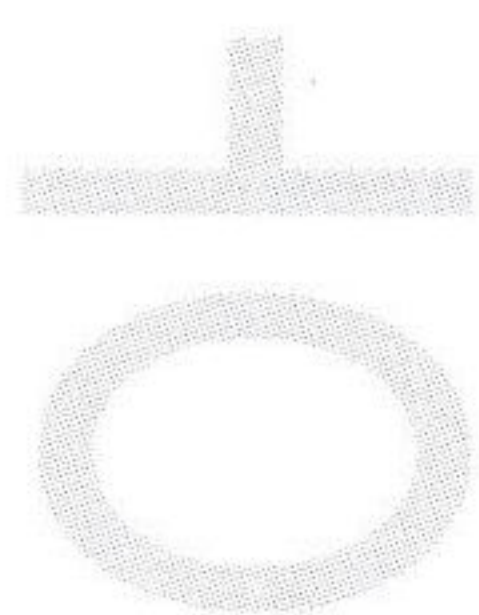

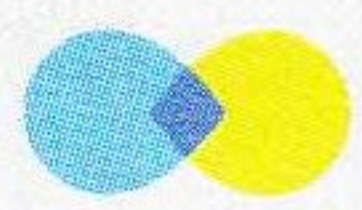
